German Championship Sprint-O: Medals for places 1–3 and Certificates for places 1–6. Prizes for the first three finishers, prize money (200/125/75 Euro) for place 1- 3 in W/M 21 (WRE).

German Championship Sprint-Relay: Medals and Certificates for place 1-3. Prizes will only be given to those present at the award ceremony.

Punching System

The electronic control system SPORTident Air+ is used. SI chips of all generations can be used. Active cards (SIAC) can be used for touch-free punching. There are no SI cards available for loan.

At the children's orienteering there is no punching of controls and no timing.

OSC Hamburg announces the following embargoed area for the Sprint-O with immediate effect: Stadtpark, City Nord and Alsterdorf in the city of Hamburg. Borders in the north: Alster river, in the west: Alsterdorfer Straße, in the east: Fuhlsbütteler Straße / Rübenkamp / Saarlandstraße, in the south: Barmbeker Straße / Grasweg / Südring. The embargo ends when the competition finishes (final run).

SC Klecken announces the following embargoed area for the Sprint-O-Relay with immediate effect: "Inselpark Wilhelmsburg aus". Borders in the north: Mengestraße, Neuenfelder Straße, in the west: Georg-Wilhelm-Straße, in the east: B75, in the south: Kornweide. The embargo ends when the competition finishes.
